

## **The Center for Data Analysis Stimulus Bill Tables and Charts**

These tables and charts present the Obama administration's stimulus bill<sup>1</sup> spending in one easy to use spreadsheet, a format not offered by the administration at [Recovery.gov](http://Recovery.gov). The added transparency created by the one spreadsheet format is useful in understanding how billions of dollars of slated stimulus bill outlays are being spent, and will be spent. Visitors to the website are encouraged to run their own calculations using Microsoft Excel or other software programs on the data. There are two charts, and we think enough data for Center for Data Analysis website users to make many more.

The first tab on the spreadsheet, called "Stimulus Spending by Dept" tracks week by week spending and funds made available by government departments and agencies. Column B lists money the President's 2010 budget states will be spent on the stimulus by the departments and agencies in fiscal year 2009 and fiscal year 2010 ending September 2010--\$460.8 billion dollars. Row 43 in Column C and up has the total and percent that has actually been spent. Row 4 to 37 in column C and up break down the weekly spending by departments.

The other tabs include a "percent spent chart" tab, a "Chart Data" tab, and a "Weekly Spent Chart" tab. All of the tabs are updated every week on the Center for Data Analysis Website as new data is released.
